
HOW TO SIGN UP FOR SUBJECT CONTENT ALERTS VIA SAVED SEARCH

Stay up to date on the latest research from the *American Journal of Clinical Pathology* and *Laboratory Medicine* with specific subject or keyword content alerts delivered to your email. This service allows you to create custom email alerts to make sure you never miss out on the latest research from the ASCP publications.


- 1. Register for an Oxford Academic account. This will allow you to sign up for email alerts, purchase content, and save searches. If you already have an account, then log in.
- 2. Navigate to the American Journal of Clinical Pathology homepage at ajcp.com or the Laboratory Medicine homepage at labmedicine.com. You can type these directly into the search bar of your browser.
 - **a.** The journal homepages can also be navigated to using https://academic.oup.com/ajcp or https://academic.oup.com/labmed.
- 3. Using the search bar on the journal's homepage, you can either search for a keyword or subject area in that specific journal alone, or for both of the ASCP journals.



4. Once you search, you will see the results screen, and at the top will be a "Save search" option.



5. Click on "Save search" and from there you will be able to name the alert and determine if you'd like to receive new content alerts daily, weekly, monthly, or twice monthly.



- **6.** Once you've made your selection, click on the "Save search" button and you will begin receiving alerts when new content is published and according to your preferences.
- 7. For Laboratory Medicine, which has specific subject area sections, users can also click on those areas and sign up for new content alerts the same way as above.
